

Short-Term Objectives

- ❖ Conditions under which the behavior will be performed
- ❖ Student behavior
- ❖ Criteria for judging acceptable performance
(The measurable criteria-quantitative)

Example #1: Given 25 basic math computations on basic addition and subtraction facts, the student will write the correct answer to 23/25 (92%) of the computations.

Example #2: When asked to identify a biology science term from memory, the student will correctly state a definition that includes the term's body function and relationship to the body system for 9 out of 10 terms (90% accuracy).

Example #3: When given a weekly spelling test of 10 words, student will correctly spell 8 out of 10 (80%) words correctly.
